Stage 1 Training Outcomes:

Participants experience an overview of the three components of the LearnIT2teach Project (the web portal, the learner courseware, and the instructor training) through interaction with a multimedia demonstration slideshow and an H5P interactive content activity.

Participants are introduced to important e-learning concepts related to the LearnIT2teach Project and the teacher training, such as blended learning, learning management systems (LMS), learning objects, and educational resources and e-activities.

Participants select a target benchmark level and complete tasks as a newcomer/learner in the LINC courseware to gain a general understanding of:

- logging on and off
- · updating their personal profile
- viewing the course gradebook
- viewing the Announcements Forum and the Checklist
- completing a Quiz activity to explore Courseware Help resources
- posting in a discussion Forum
- making a selection in a Choice activity
- submitting a response for an online text/PoodLL voice (recording) Assignment
- adding an entry to a Glossary
- · completing a needs assessment Questionnaire activity
- adding an entry to a learning style preference Database
- viewing printable curriculum and classroom resources
- interactive reading & listening SCORM activities [SCORM = Shareable Content Object Reference Model]
- Wiki tasks

Participants are introduced to research-based good teaching principles and relate these to the LMS & learner courseware.
