

## Speaking: The 'name it' challenge

- 5 Work in pairs or small groups. Get ready to play a game. First, read the rules. Is everything clear?
- 6 One important rule is missing. Decide what it should be. Come to a joint decision.

What should you do when someone gives a wrong answer?

- a Give them no points?
- b Make them lose points? How many?

- 7 Now play the game. If necessary, make up more rules as you play.

### Rules

- 1 The person with the largest feet starts. The person with the smallest feet keeps score.
- 2 Toss a coin to move around the board. Heads: move one square. Tails: move two squares.
- 3 Try to complete the challenge on each square. If you're successful, you score the point(s). If not, you get no points.
- 4 When you take too long to complete a challenge, you lose a point.
- 5 If you land on a square someone landed on before, you can choose to move onto the next square, or try the challenge, too.
- 6 The person with the most points at the end is the winner.
